THE PAINT REUSE MODEL



1. DONATE

Members of the public donate paint at collaborating Recycling Centres. All water-based non-hazardous paints can be donated and reused. To maximise opportunities for reuse, paint should be donated as soon as possible after you have completed the job.



2. SCREEN

Recycling Centre staff set aside the donated paint. Paint Reuse Network member organisations screen the paint, ensuring all paint collected is not expired, mouldy, or stagnant.



3. COLLECT

Anything that is usable is taken by our members to their workshops. Usually about 50% of the water-based paint donated can be reused.



4. MIX

Paint is filtered for impurities and remixed. We strive to work solely with the paint available. On very rare occasions a little pigment may be used to achieve a particular colour.



5. SELL

Paint is now ready for the shelves! The nominal fee we charge helps to cover our expenses and generates revenue to support the training and employment opportunities provided by our members.
